State Librarian's Report

1. Hawaii's Library Snapshot Day

To coincide with April's National Library Week, the American Library Association sponsored Library Snapshot Day, which provided an opportunity to show what happens in a single day in America's libraries. The Hawaii State Public Library System (HSPLS) provided a snapshot of the many programs and services to be provided in our libraries on April 28, 2010. On a single day, our libraries will welcome almost 24,000 patrons, more than 1,700 of whom will use one of our internet computers; check out more than 25,000 library materials including 2,668 dvds; host 23 programs to be enjoyed by more than 600 people; and offer a total of 382 public service hours!

2. Friends of the Library of Hawaii Book Sale, June 18-27

Mark your calendars for the Friends of the Library of Hawaii's 63rd Annual Book Sale, which will be held from June 18-27 in the McKinley High School Cafeteria. Days, hours and special promotions for this event are listed on the attached flier. Last year's Book Sale raised more than \$168,000 for programs, materials and services for Hawaii's public libraries. Thanks to the Department of Education for making facilities available for this event.

3. Enjoy an eBook or Audiobook this Summer

HSPLS now has a combined collection of more than 13,000 eBooks and audiobooks that are available for downloading from our website, www.libraqrieshawaii.org. These items are available 24/7 and may be downloaded to a computer, CD, iPod, eBook reader or other electronic reading device. There are no late fines or fees, and all you need to get started is a library card, internet connection and storage device.

4. Summer Reading Program 2010, June 1 through July 2

This year's HSPLS Summer Reading Programs for children, teens and adults have already begun, and they will continue until July 2. Themes this year are "Make a Splash @ your library" for the Children's Program; "Team Read @ your library" for the Young Adult Program; and "Exercise Your Mind @ your library" for the Adult Program. Our record number of sponsors continues to grow, as just last week, the Friends of the Library of Hawaii (FLH) received a donation of \$6,500 from Hawaiian Telcom. Attached is a list of sponsors for this year's programs.

Booksale 2010 Job Descriptions

Set-up Crew (June 16 - 18)

Set up tables and shelves and display books for sale. Sign up for a shift on any of these days. Any help on these days is greatly appreciated.

Floater and Will Call (June 18 - 27)

For all other jobs on-site including manning the will-call area and relieving any workers in need of a break.

Restockers (June 18 - 27)

Hand truck books from restocking area and replenish appropriate sections. Floor managers and table monitors will give direction as to what's needed in each section.

Door Monitors/Greeters (June 18 - 27)

Greet customers as they enter sales area and assist security monitors.

Table Monitors (June 18 - 27)

Oversee various sections to determine which categories need restocking, arrange the books neatly and attractively; help restockers find "holes" and help reshelve books that have been misplaced.

Clean-up Crew (June 27, 1 - 5 p.m.)

Clean, sweep, and tidy up sales floor. On the last day of the sale, help pack remaining inventory, wipe tables, sweep, and return cafeteria to its original state.

Adders (June 18 - 27)

Add the prices marked in books selected for purchase. Direct customers to cashiers for payment.
